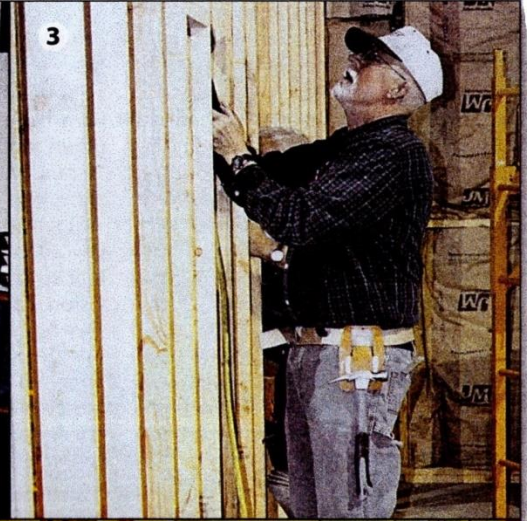


Missions & ministry:
